As we get closer to joining FACT BC, we have begun putting into place policies and procedures that we believe will be required of us, once we gain membership.



As it stands now, CACHE is requiring each member to complete 12 hours of continuing education, and 12 hours of supervision. A record of this will be required at each renewal, so we can assure each member is meeting membership requirements. A log sheet is provided on the website to make this as easy as possible for everyone.
